Baby **sad.**







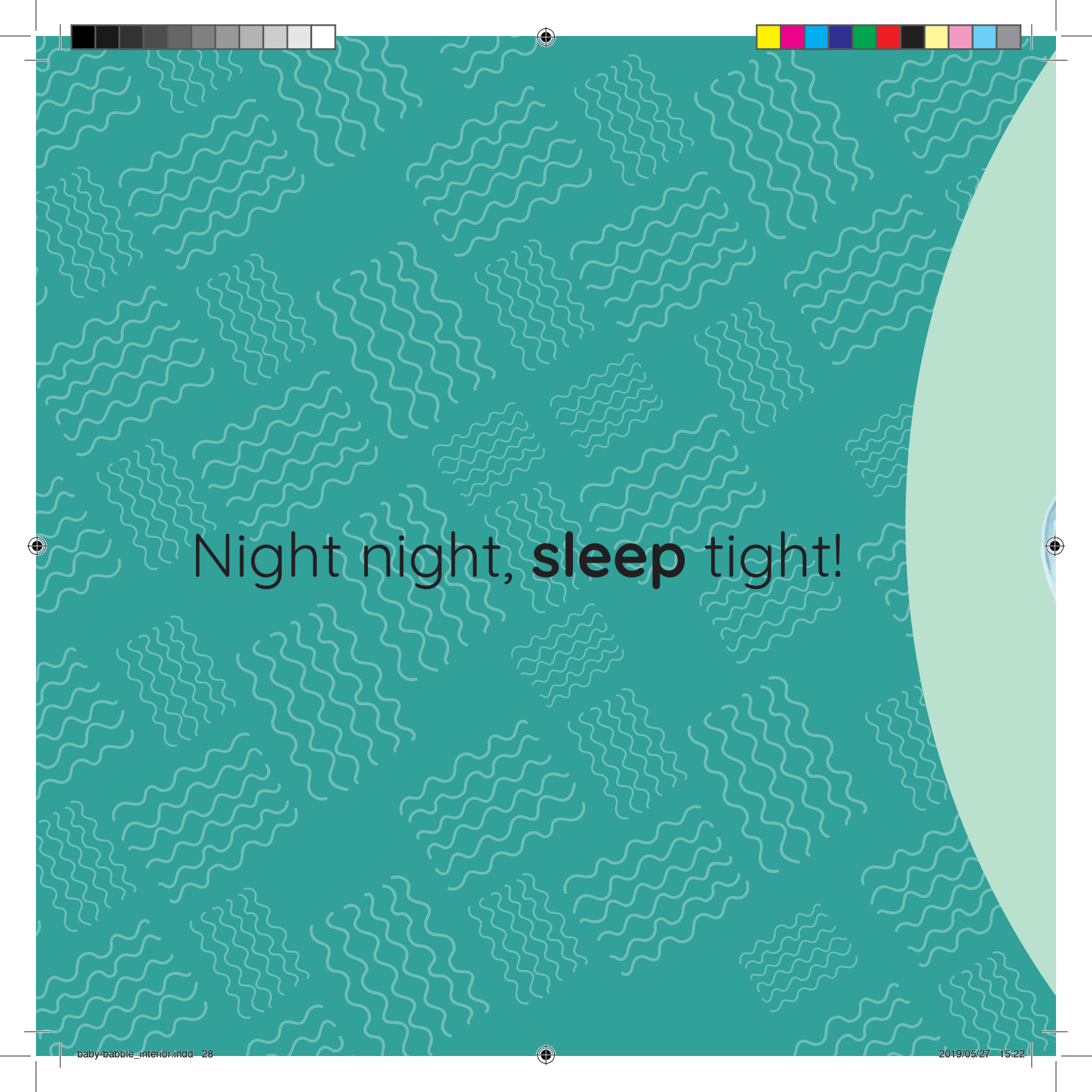
