back to school.

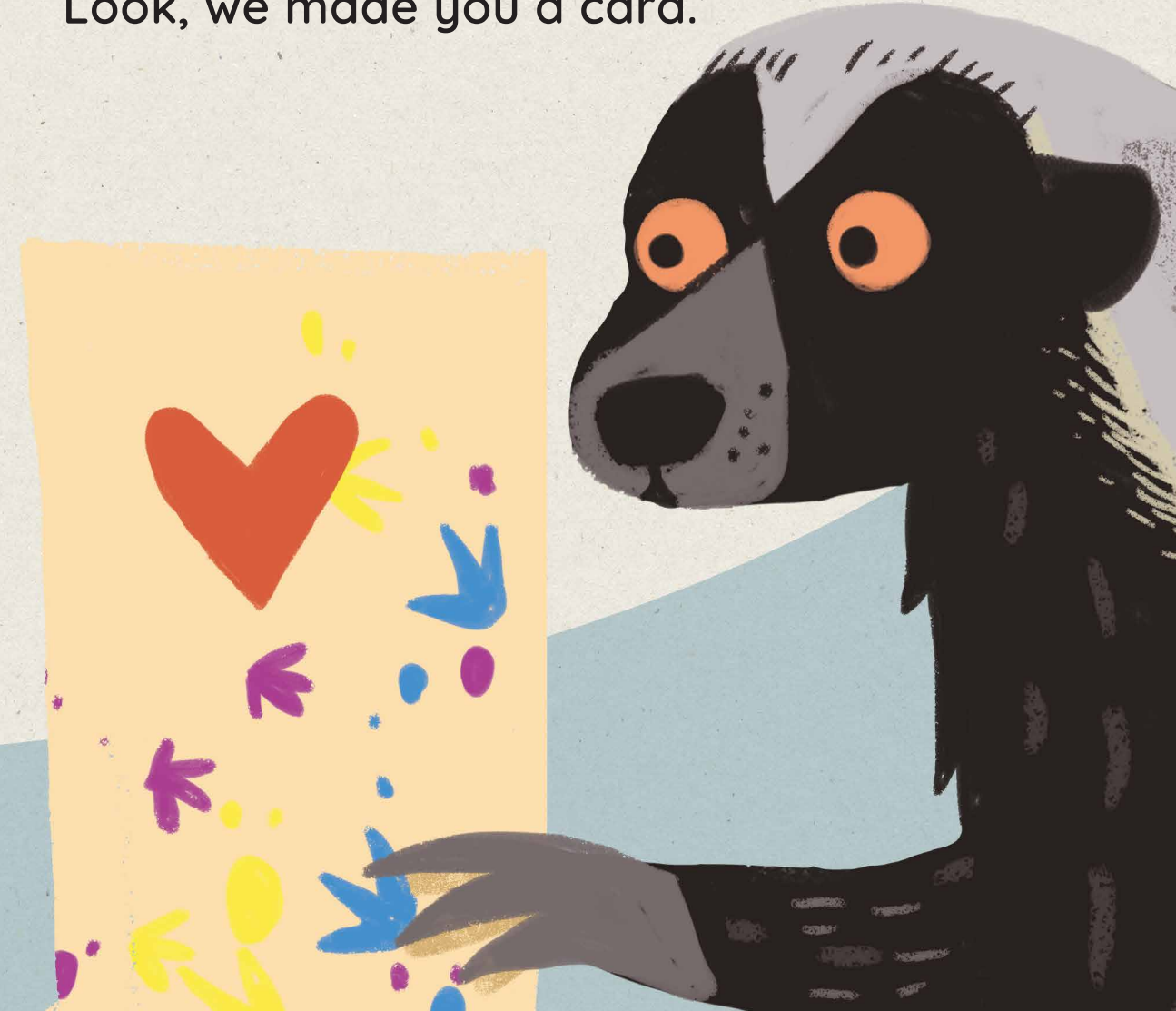


‘Let’s go read a book with Oswin!’
