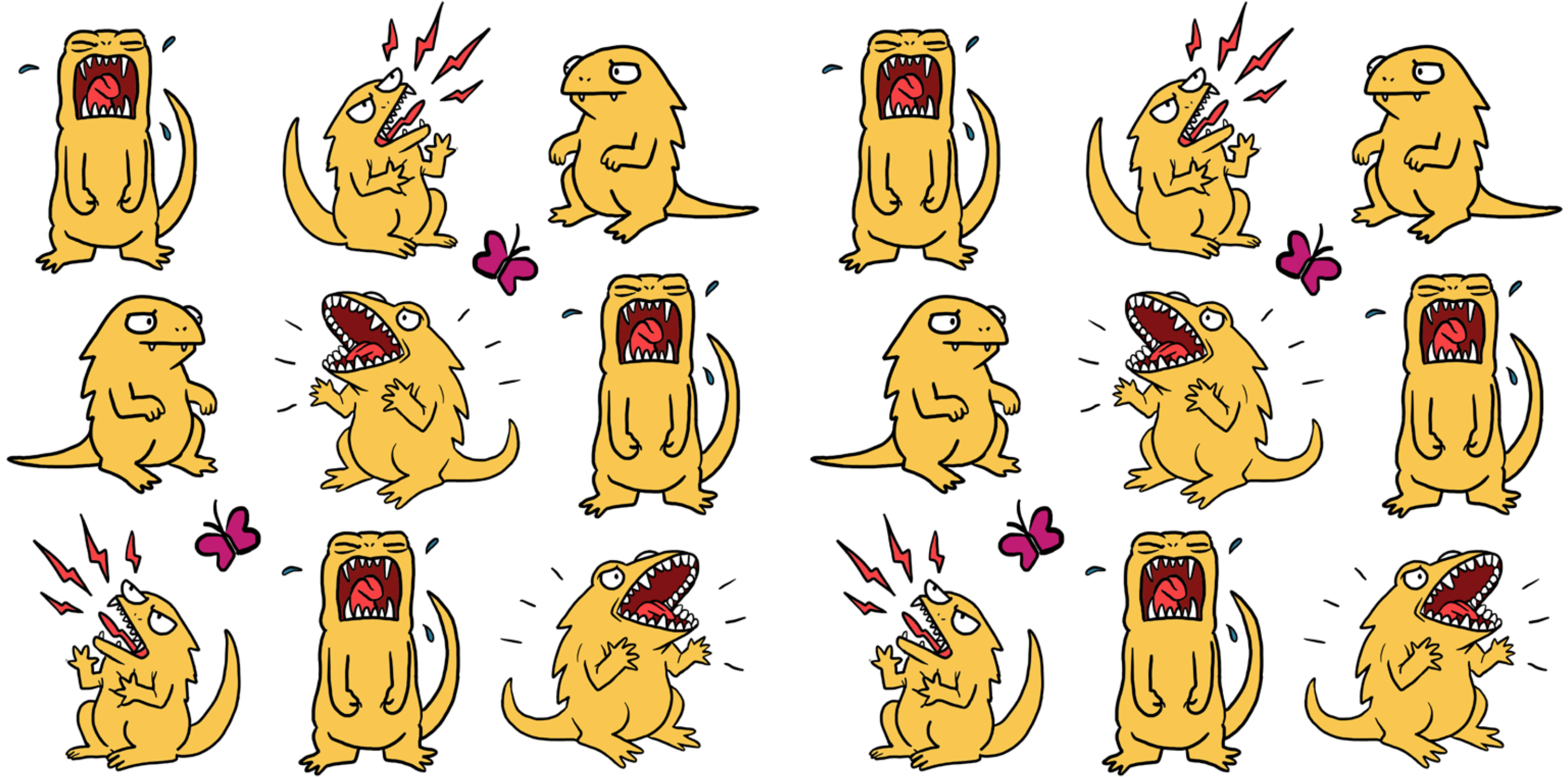

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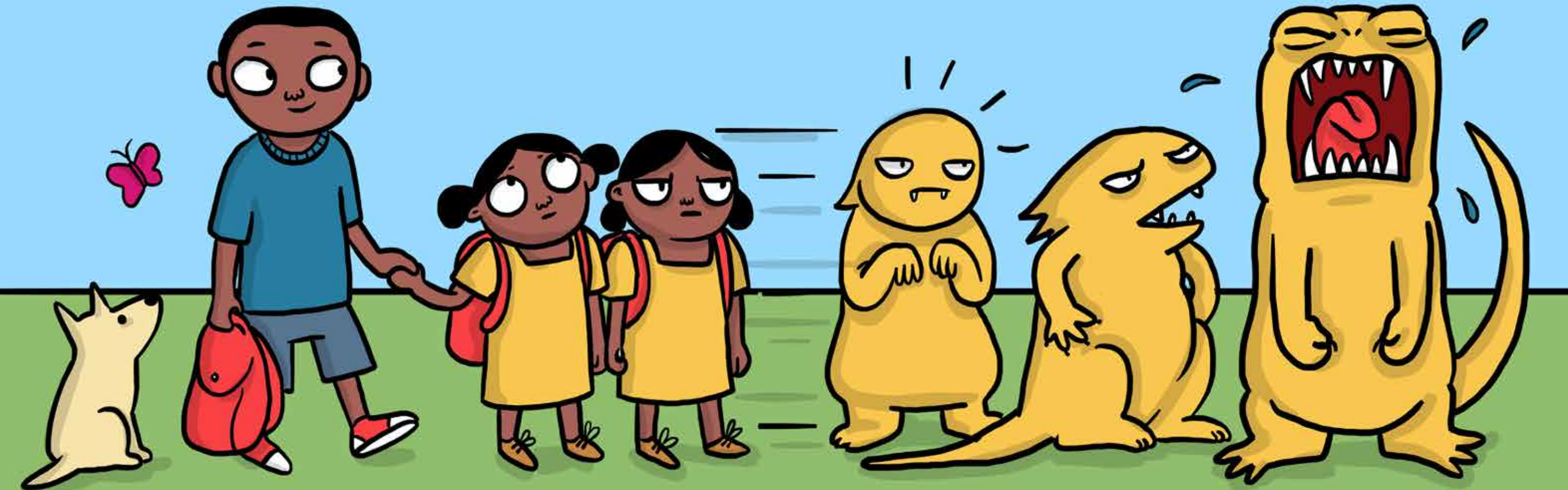
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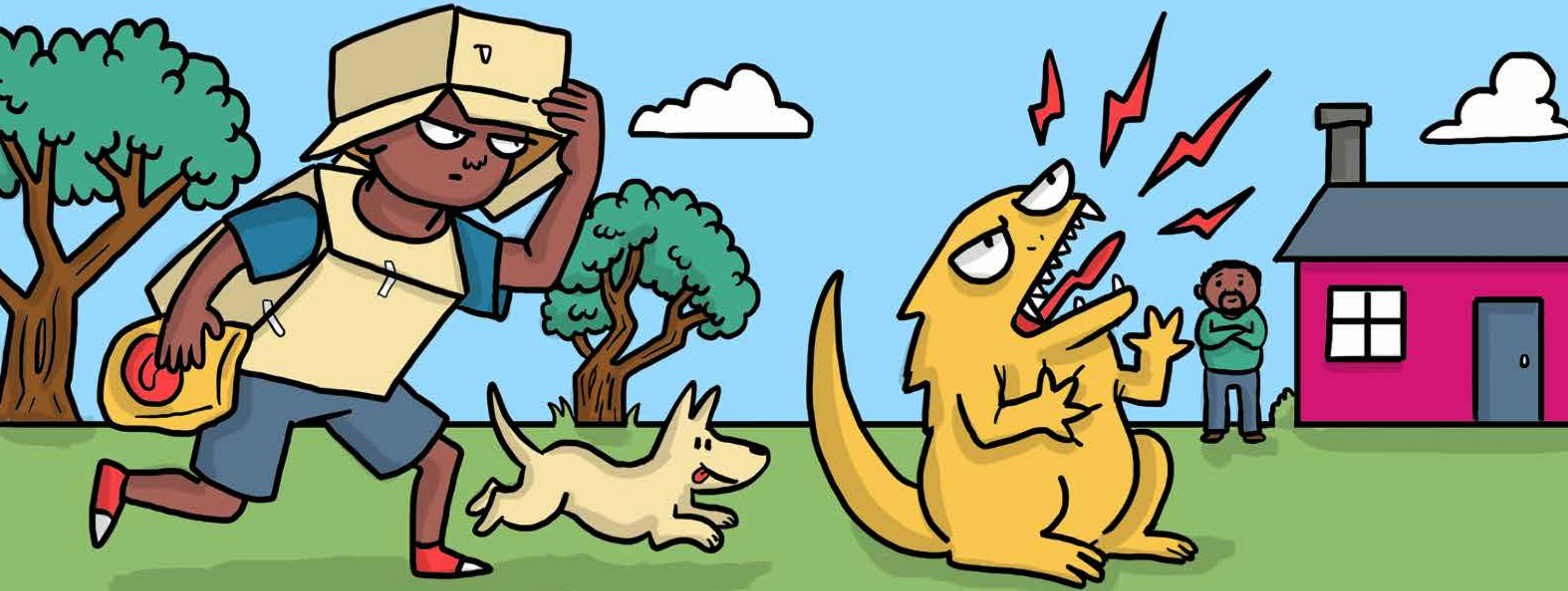
Lwando has a little sister named Oyiso.

a monster.



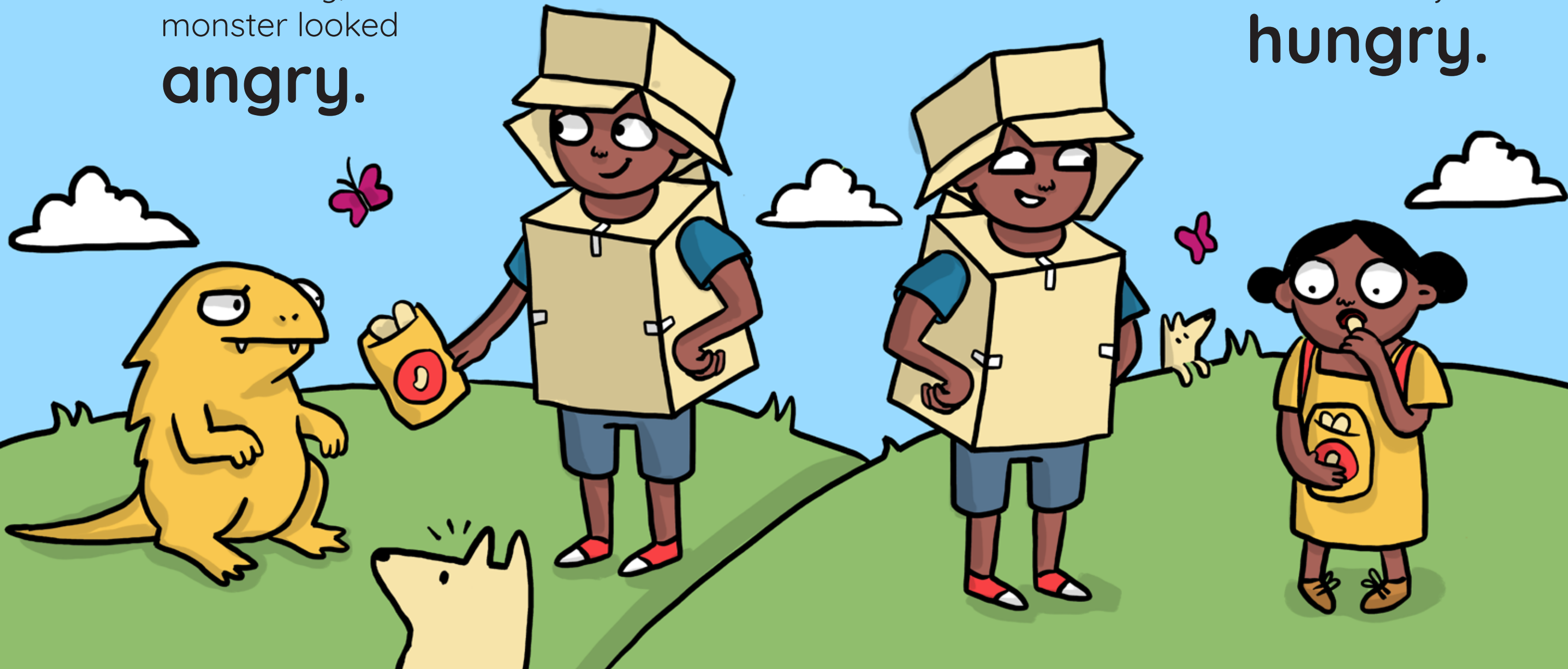
That's okay, because Lwando is a

monster tamer.



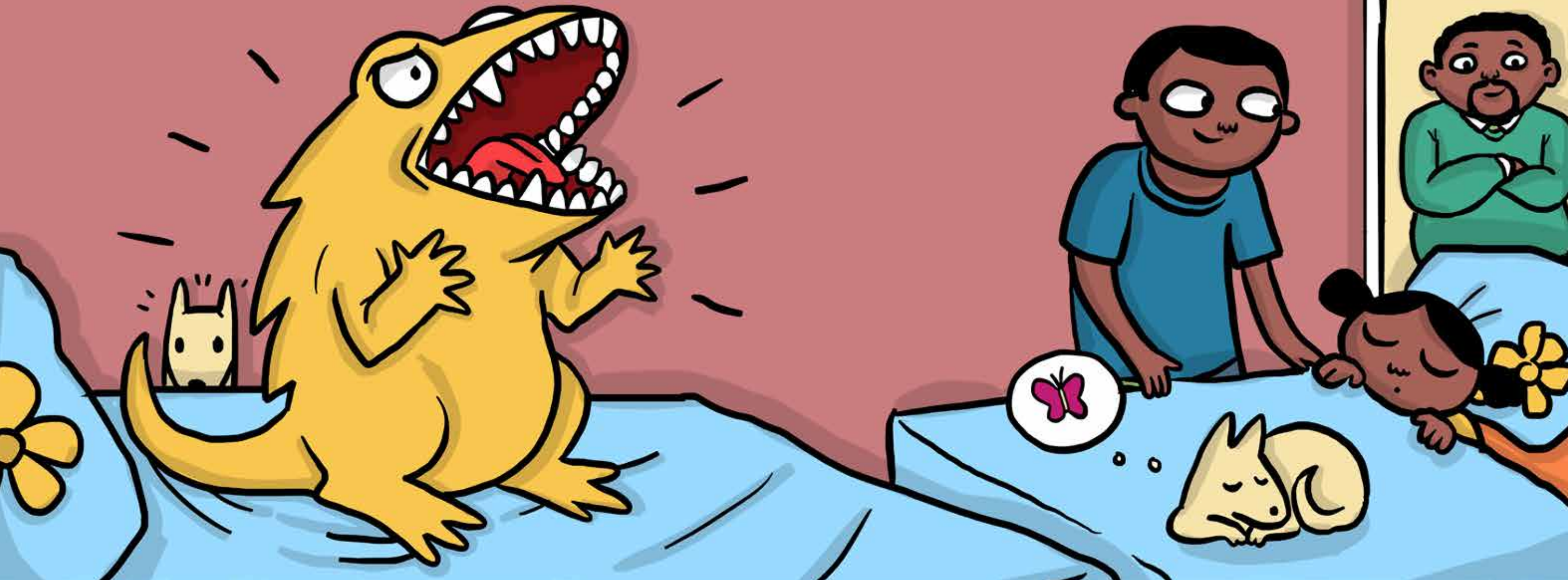
On Monday, the

hungry.



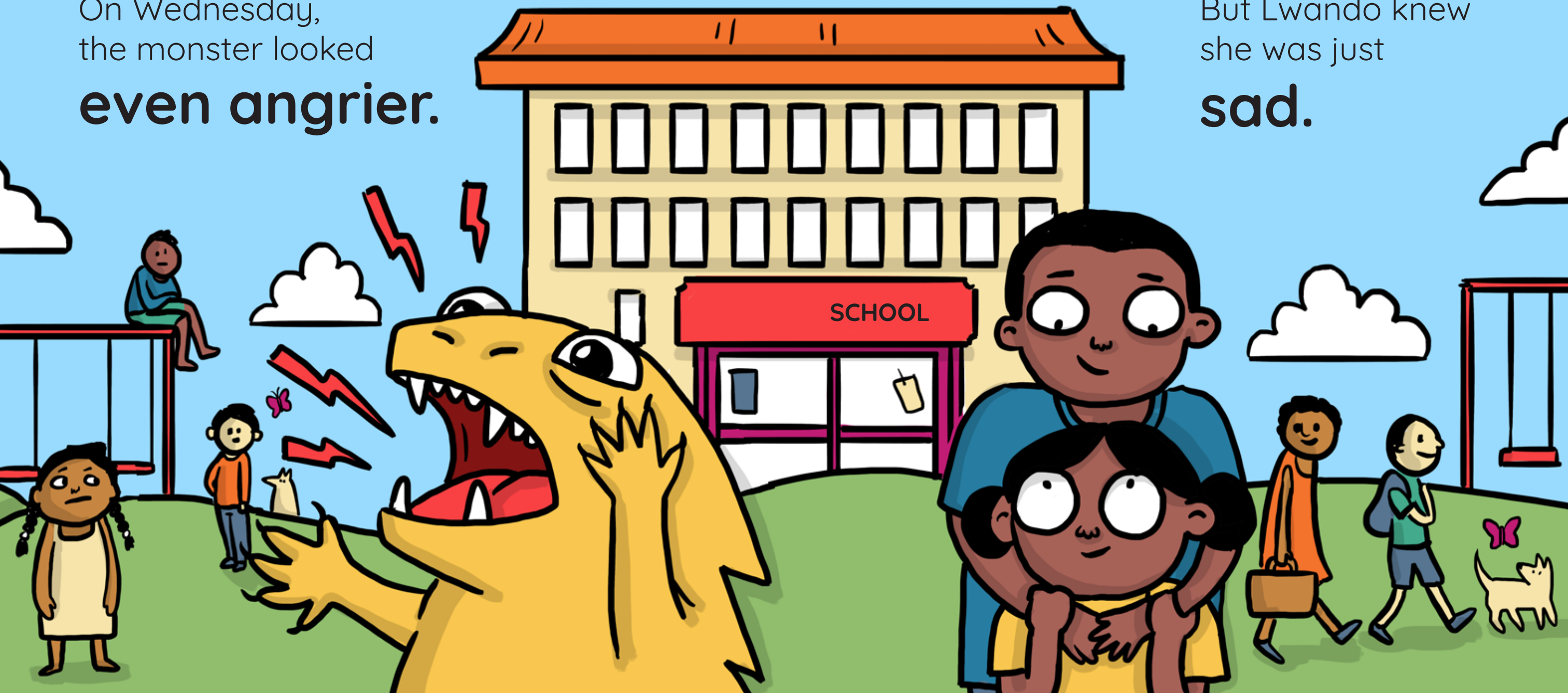
On Tuesday, the monster looked

The monsters got **bigger.**

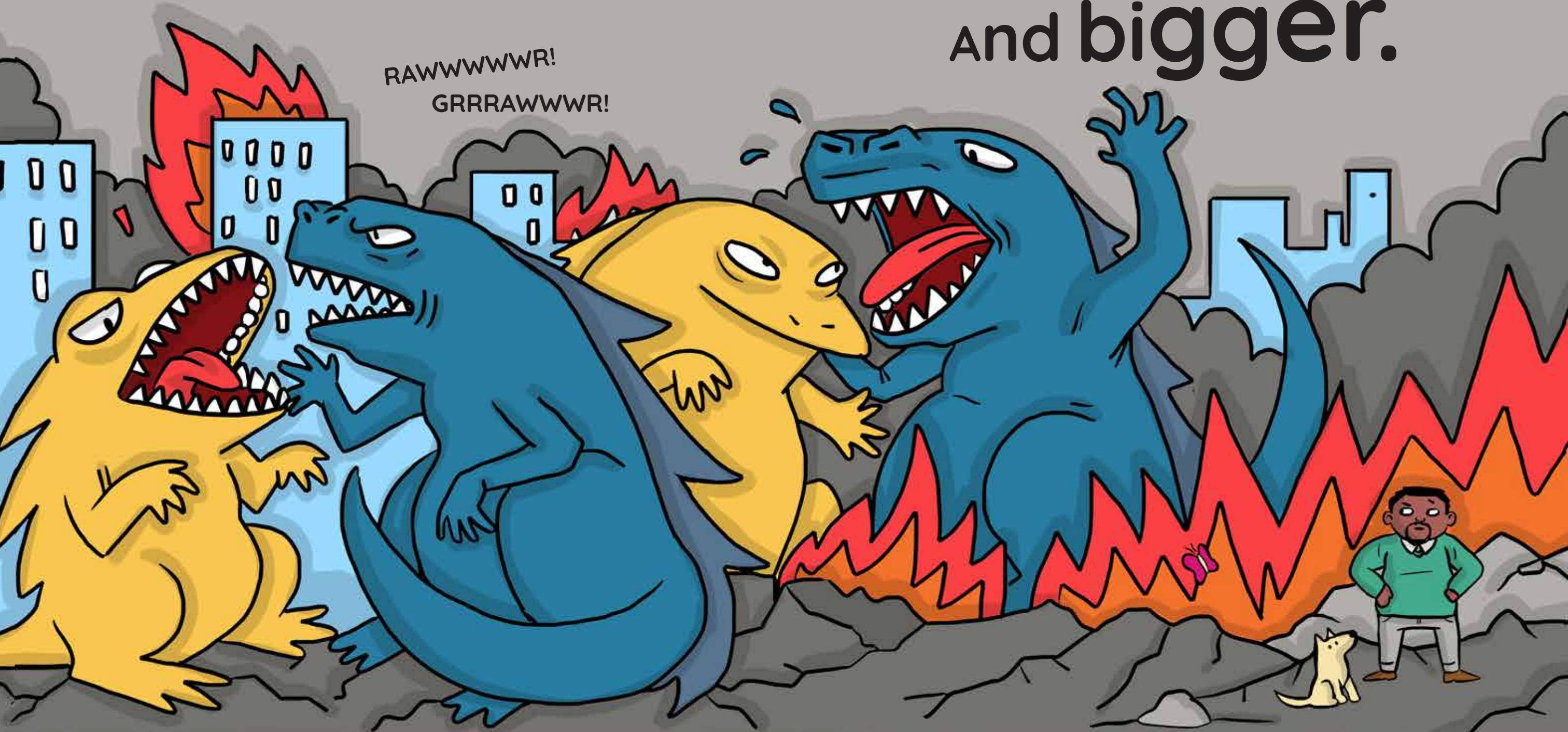

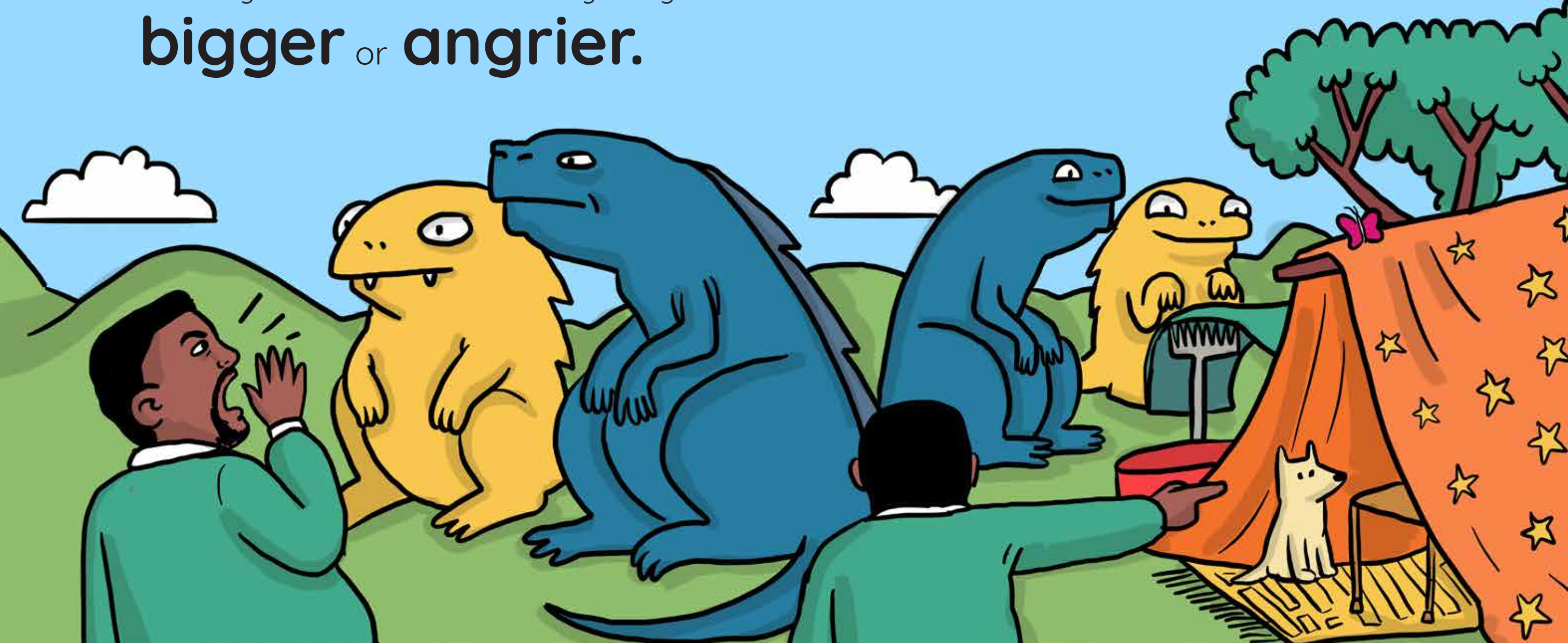
