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Can you see me?

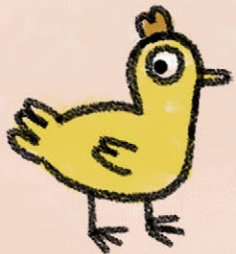
I'm on Mama's back

Shhh





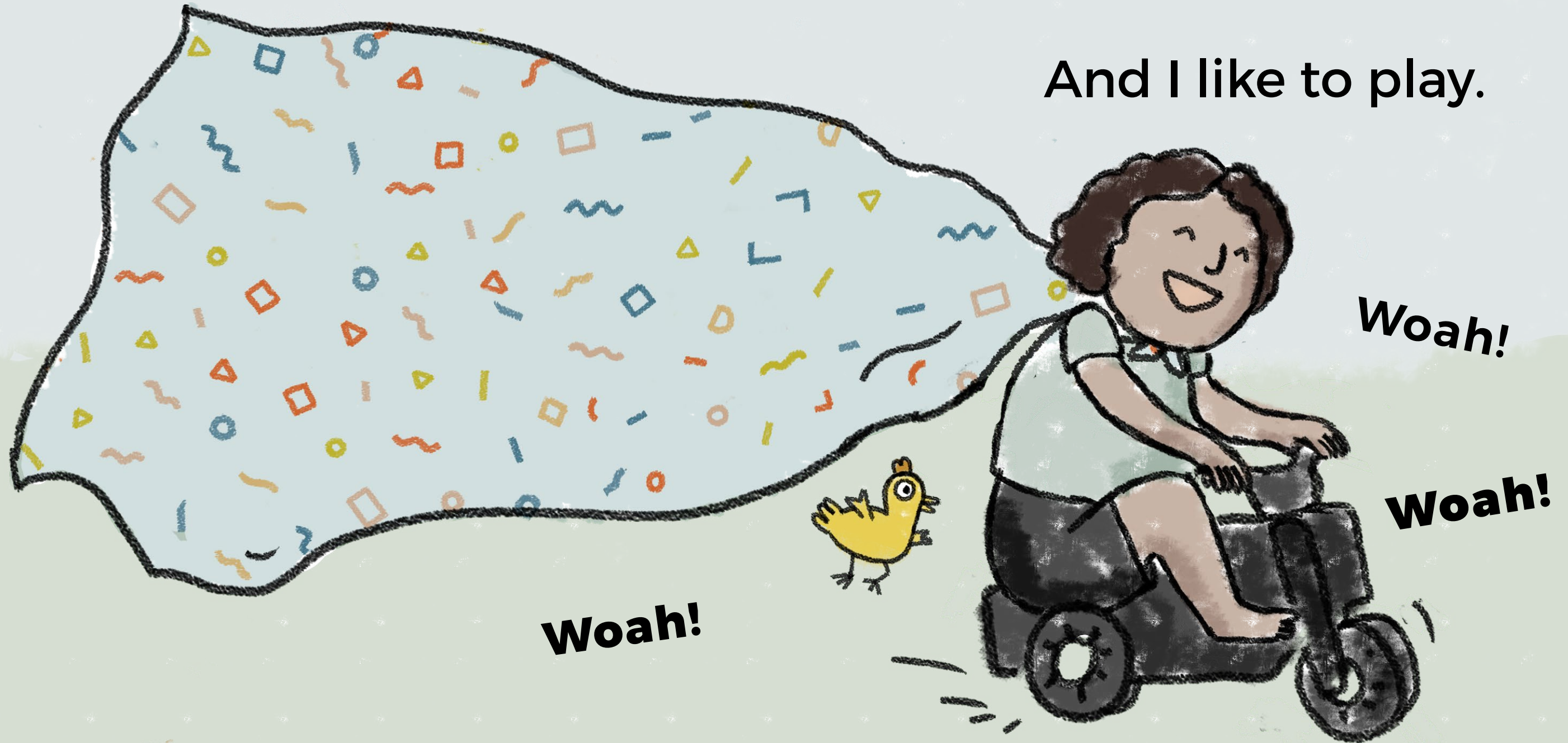
Mama does her work.
