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My Special Hair

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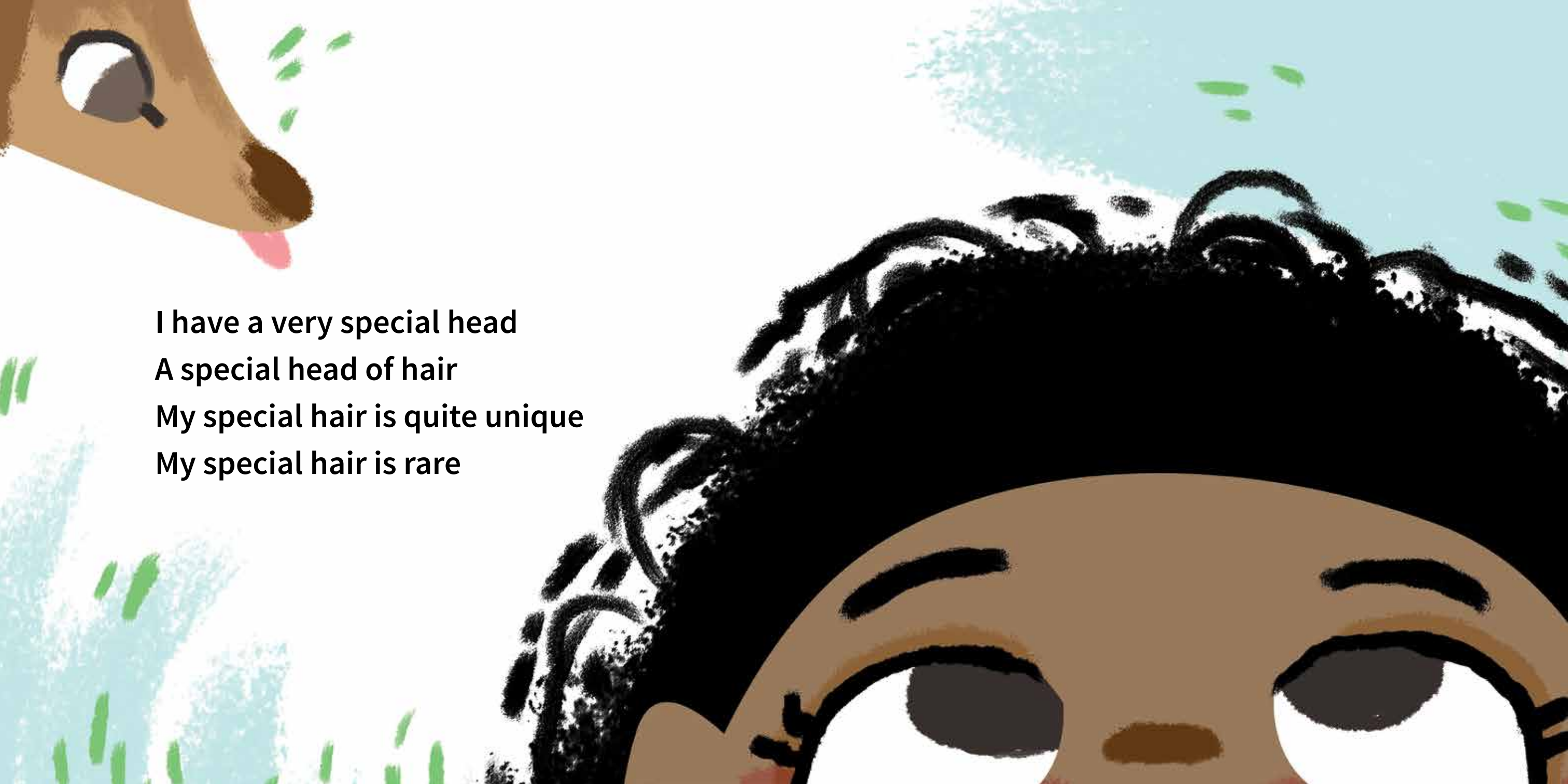

It's magic hair, you see

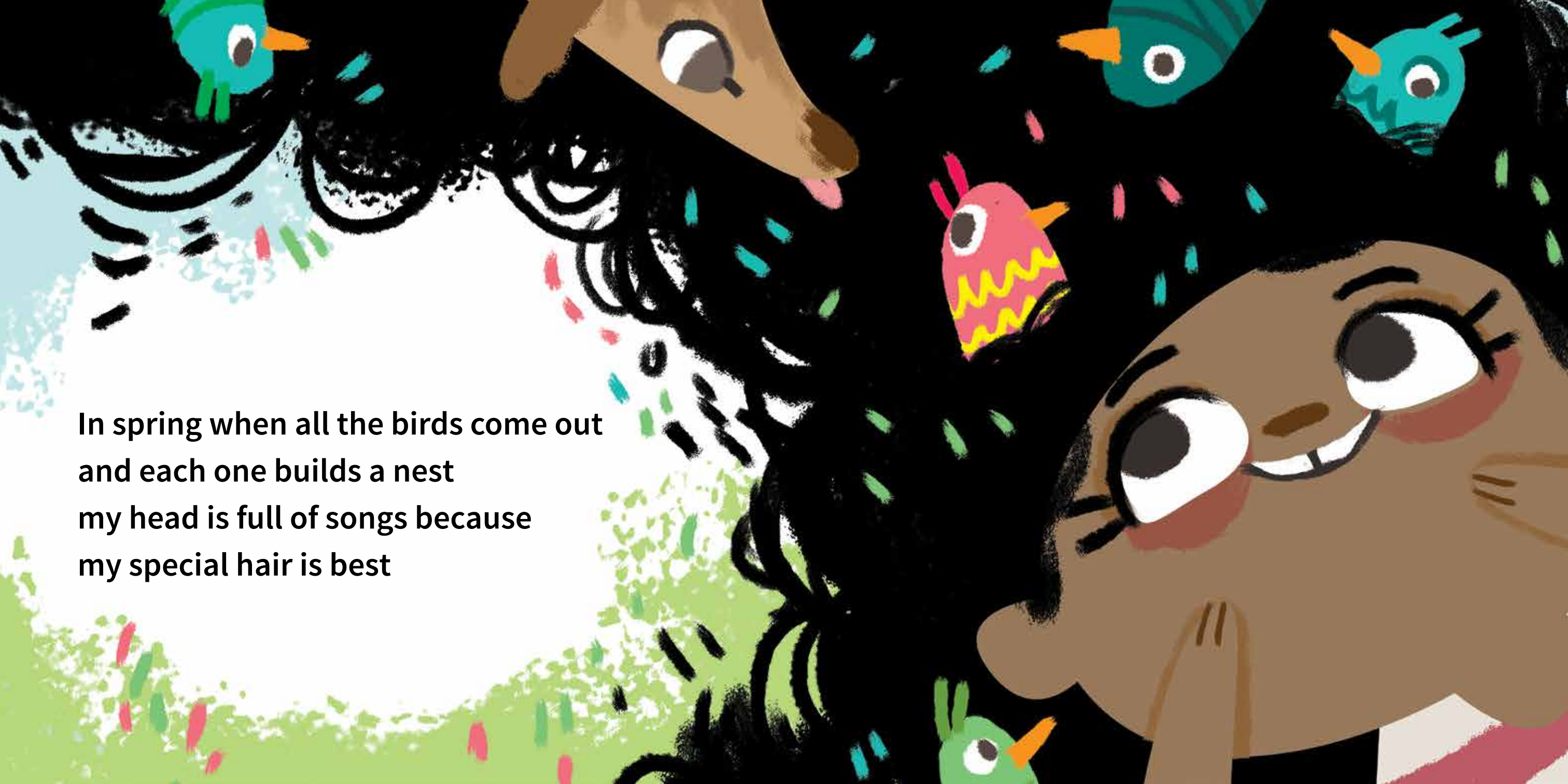




In summer when the sun is hot

So smooth

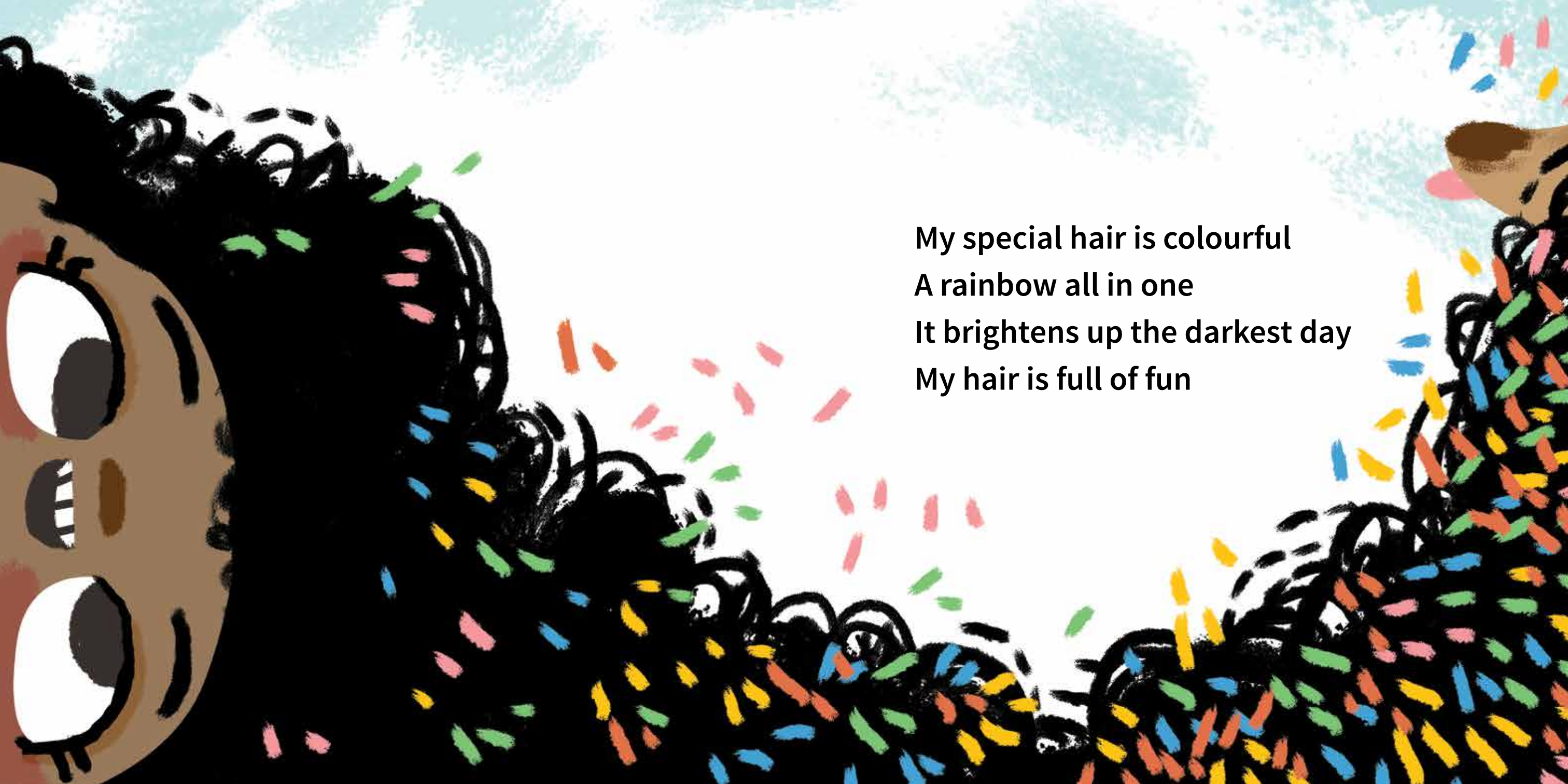
so soft

They float around my face

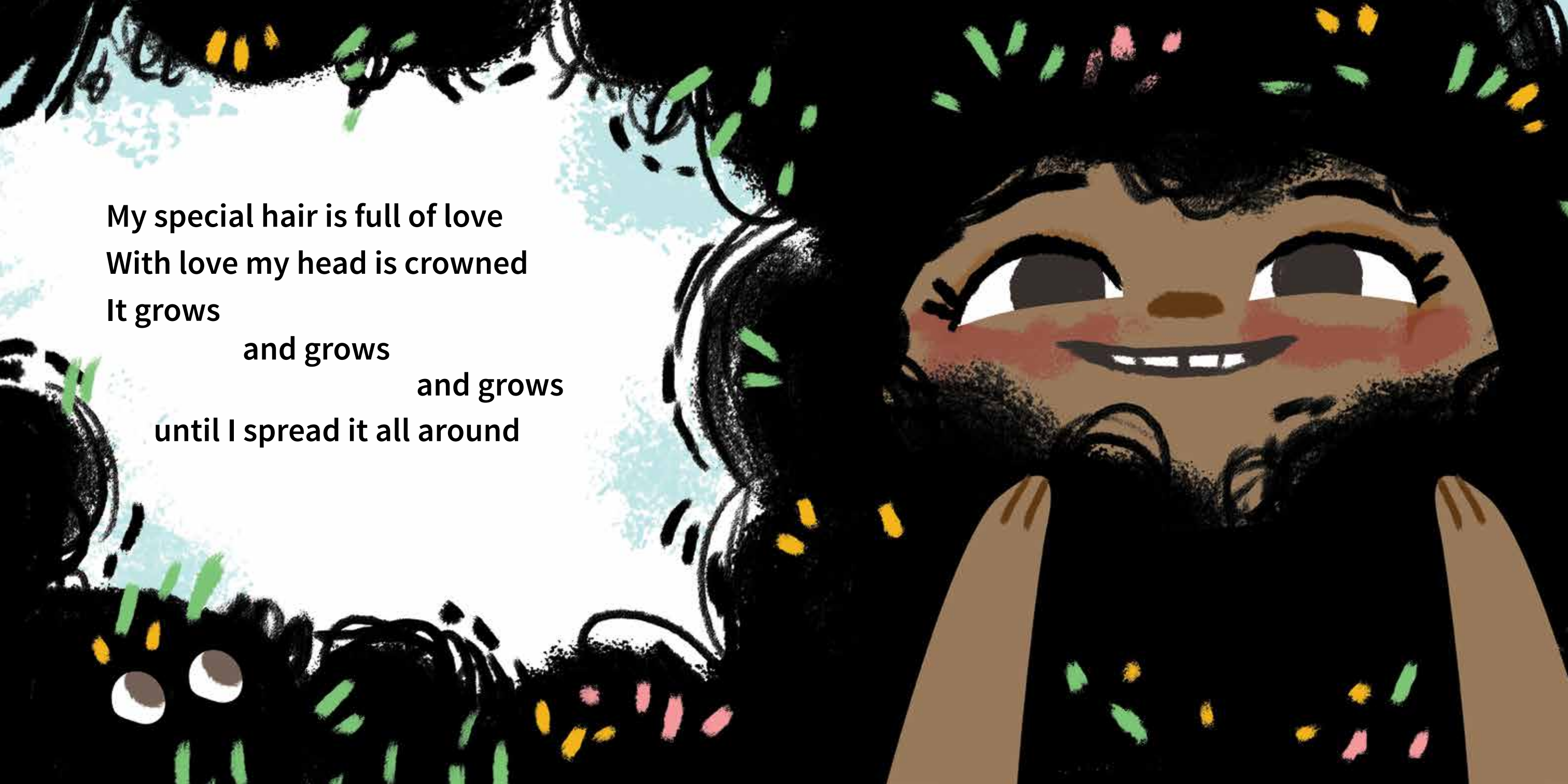
until my hair and I take flight
