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Samoosas!

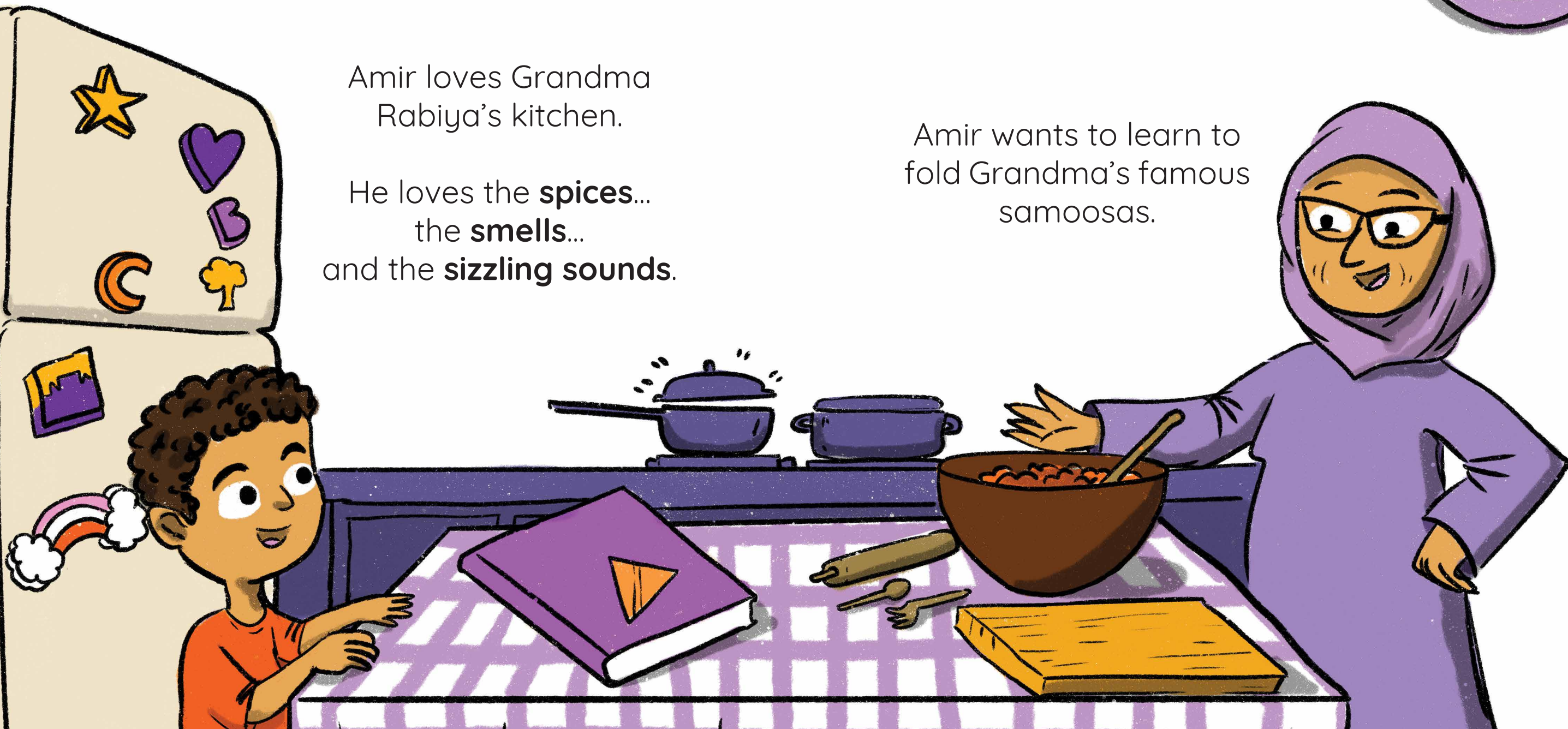
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Amir loves Grandma

laughs Amir.



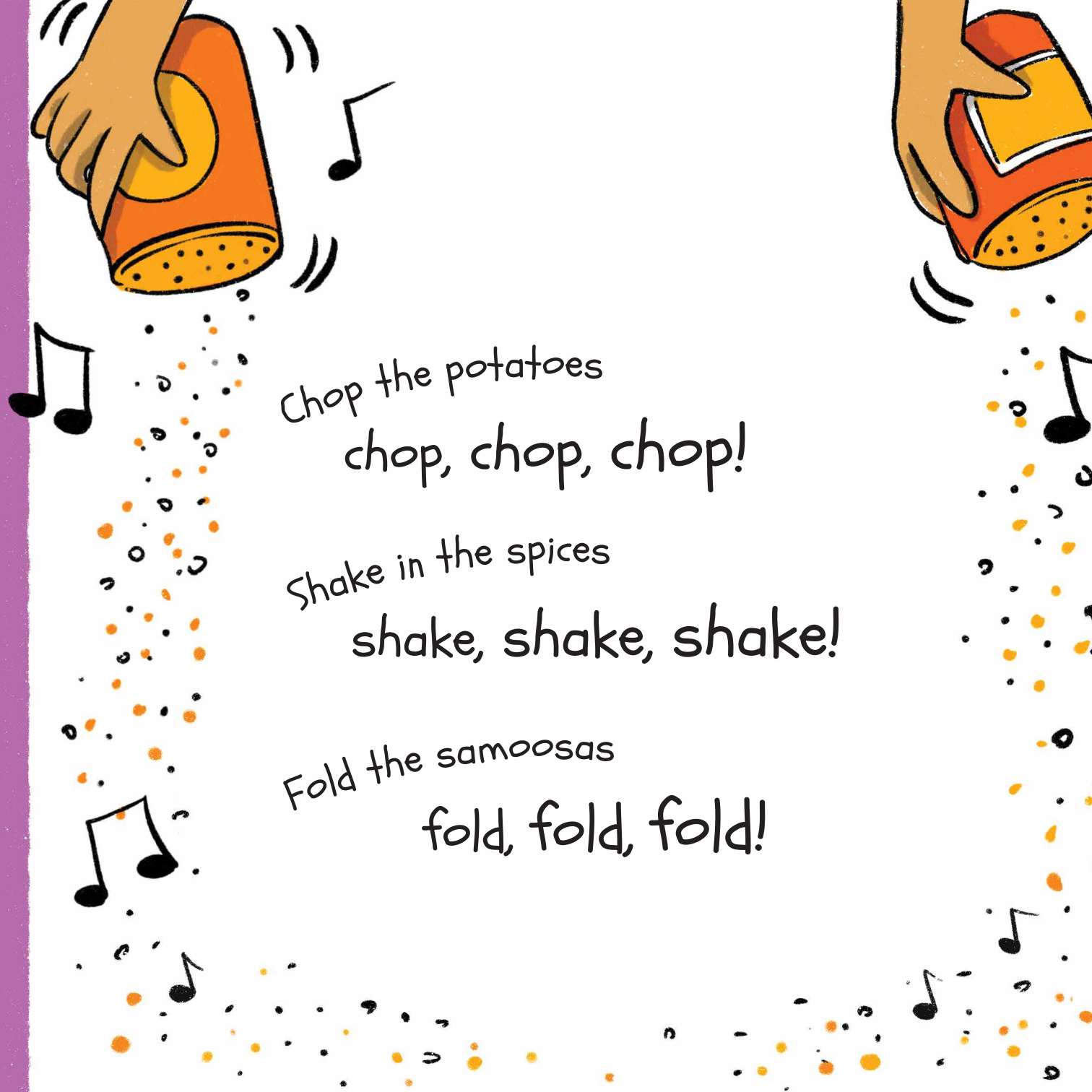


Are they

they're triangles!

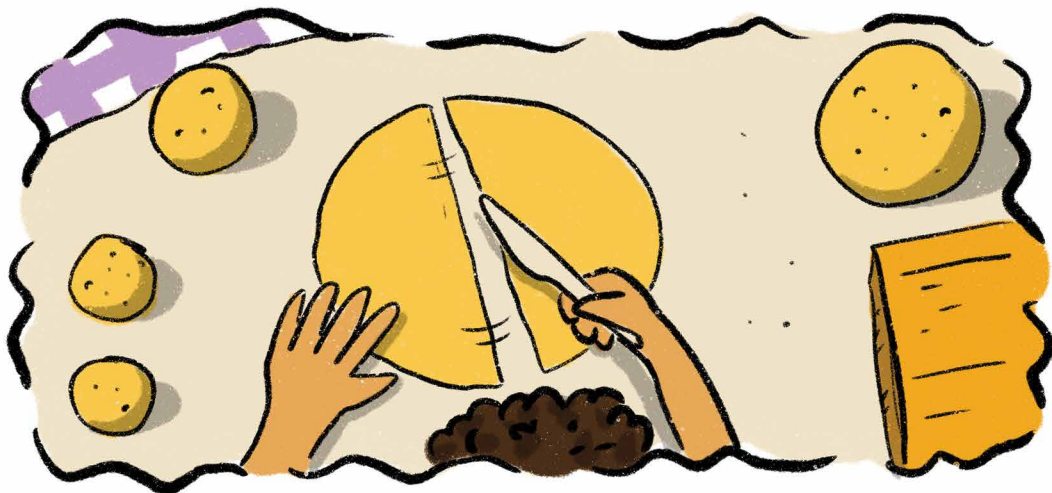
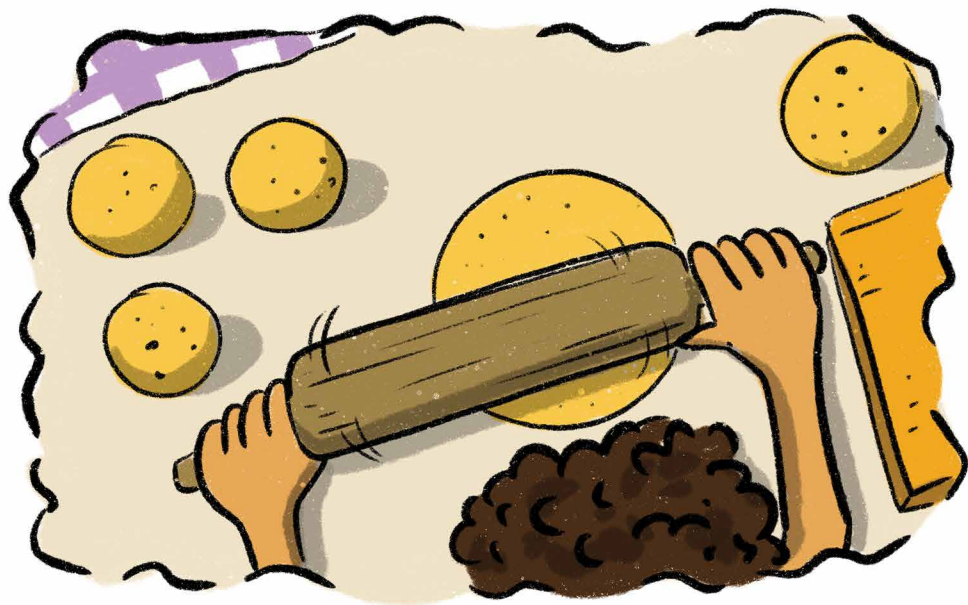
They sing

fold, fold, fold!



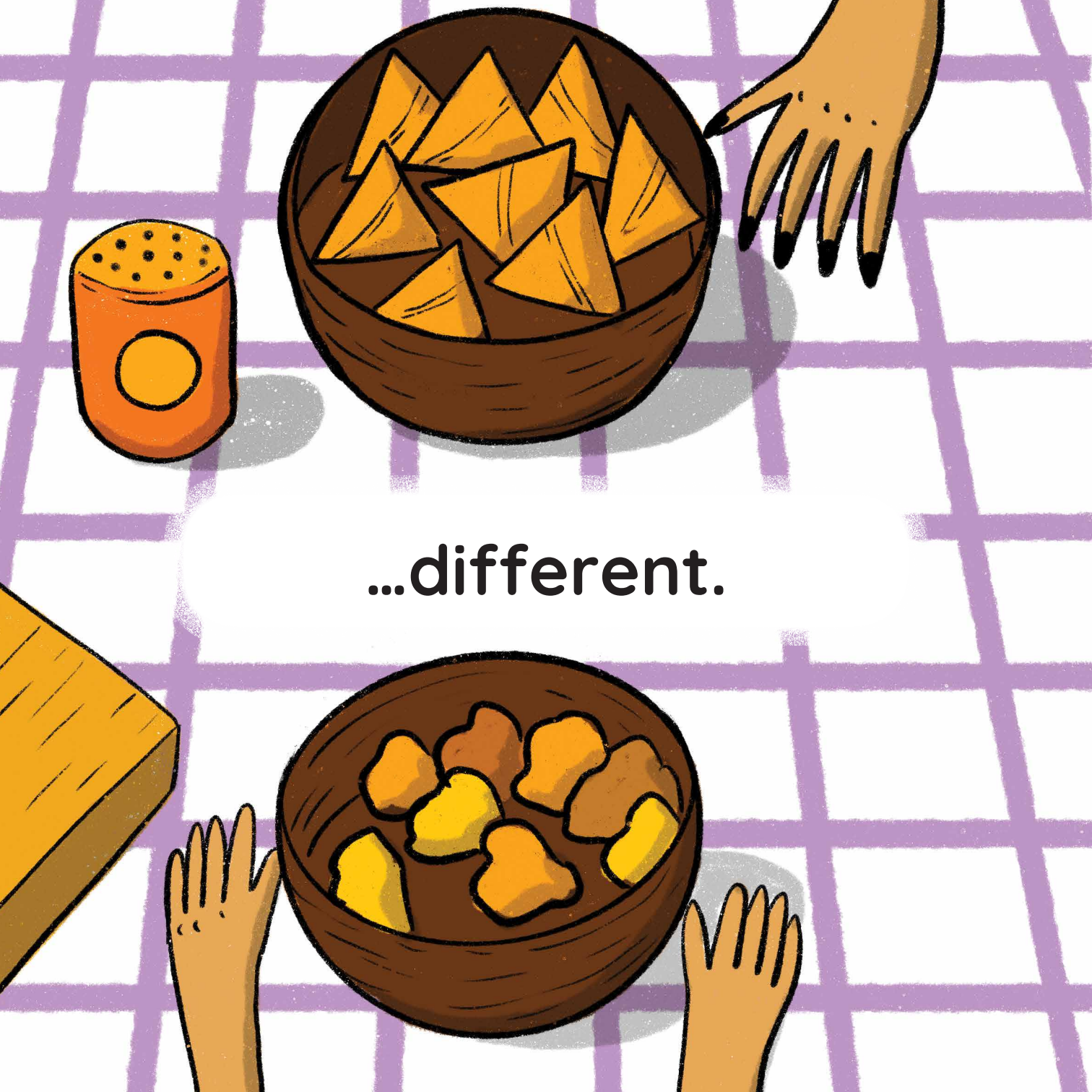
Amir copies Grandma.

But Amir's samoosas look...





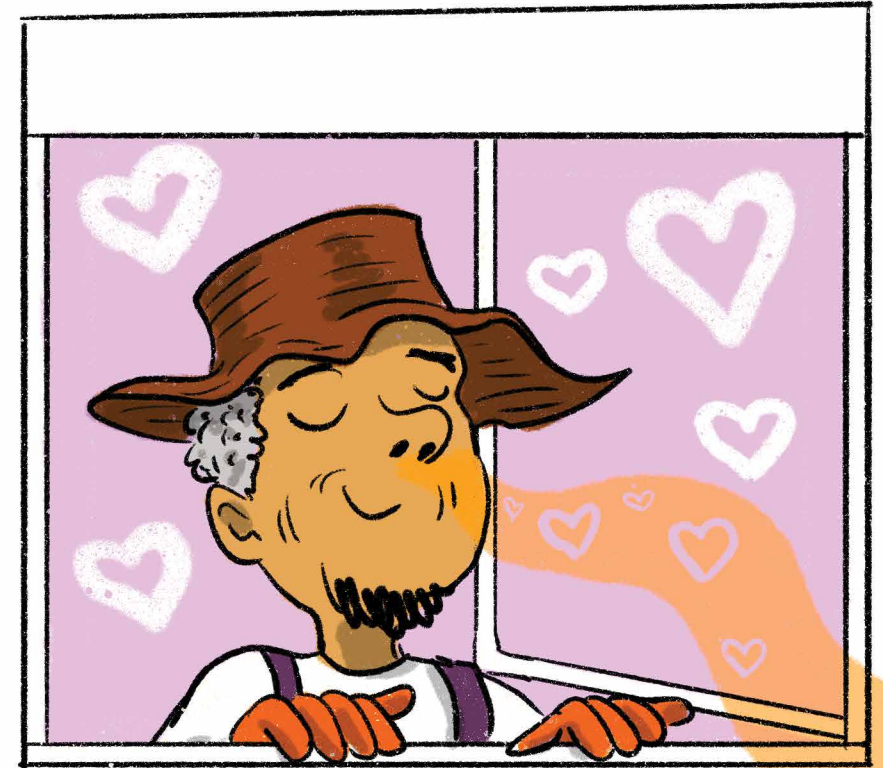
They're not triangles!

But they're not the same!

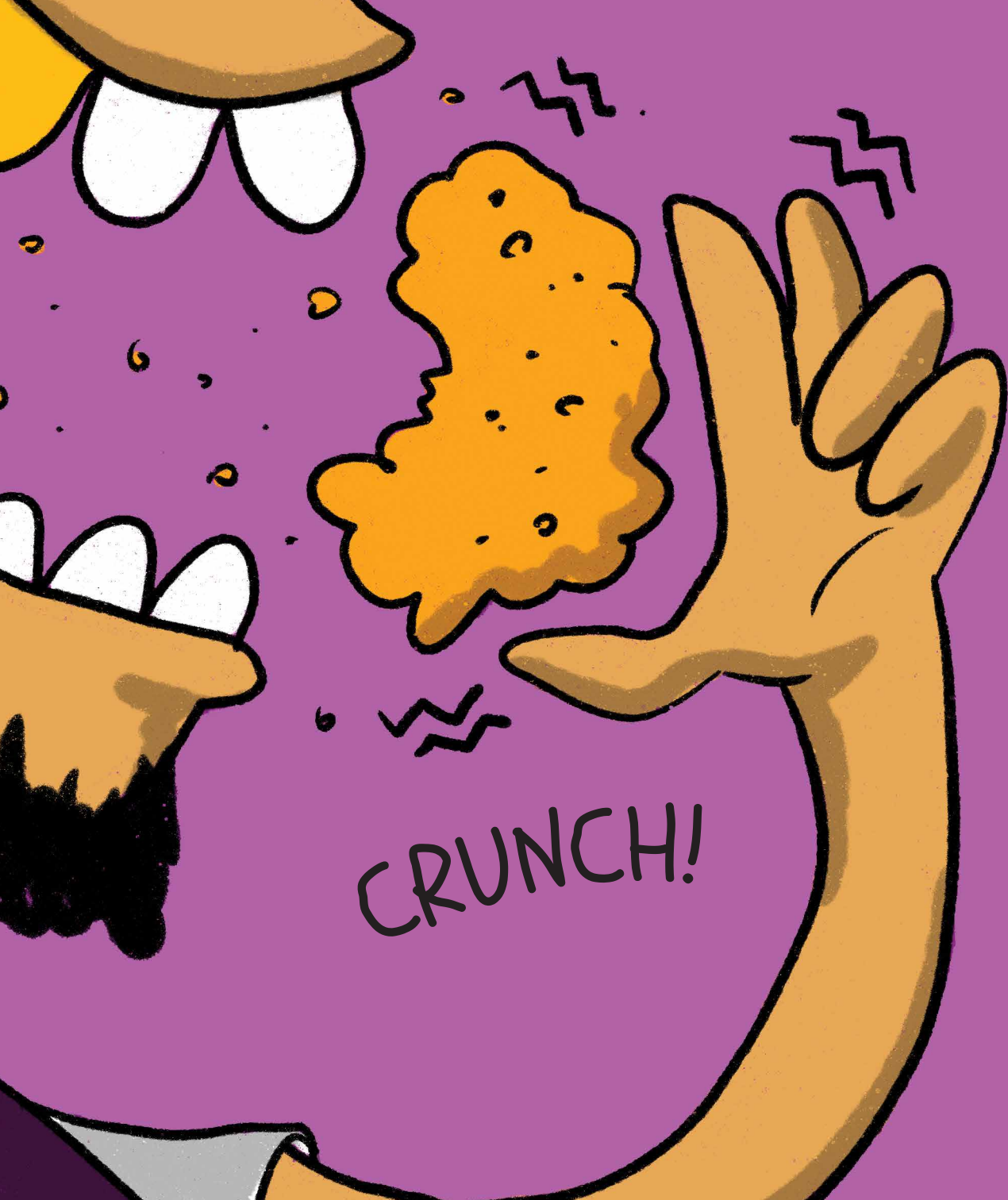
I give up!

samoosas are a hit.



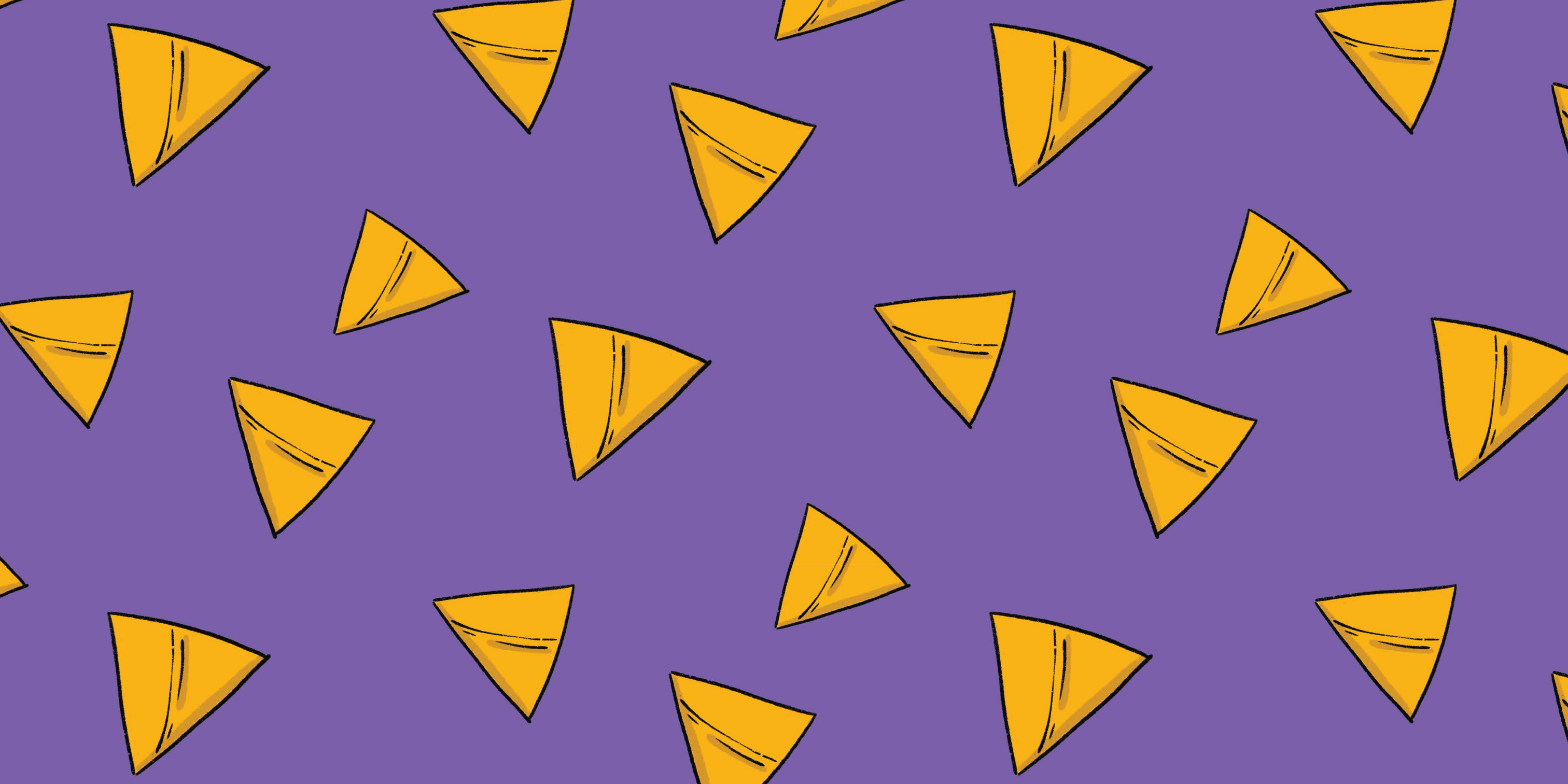
From that day on Amir would

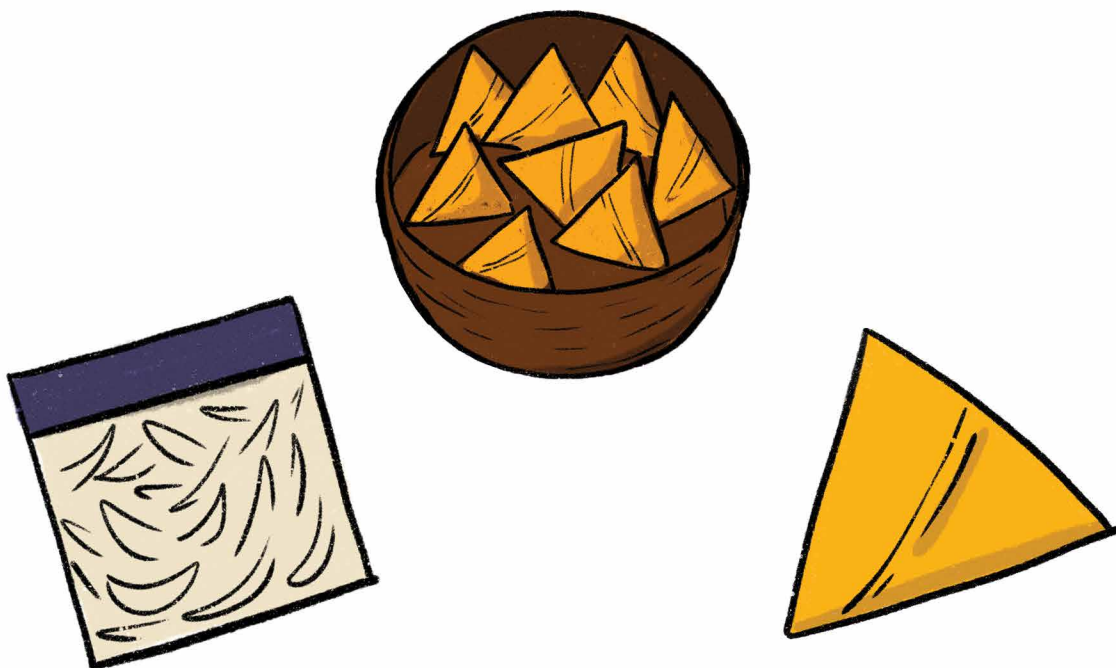
chop, chop, chop!
