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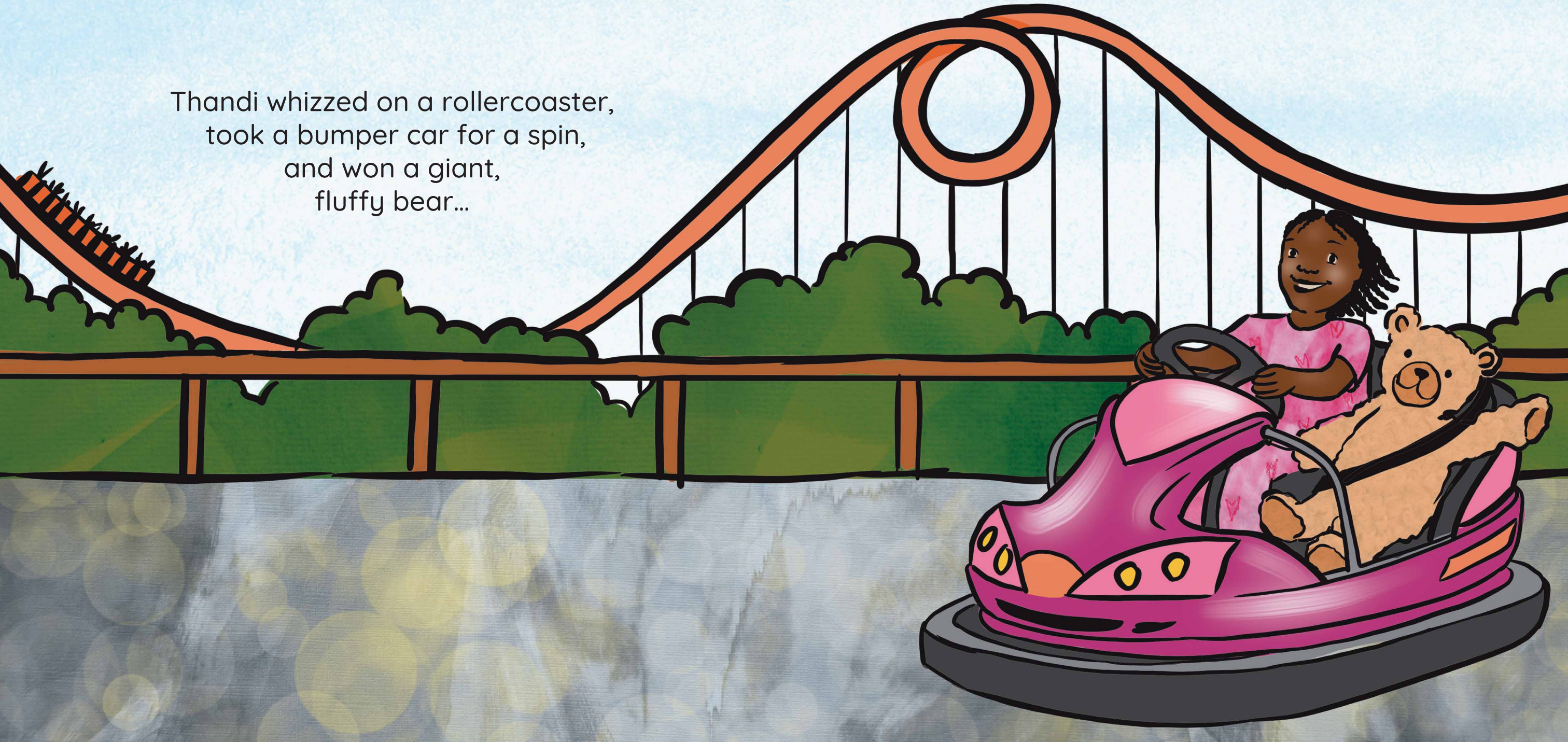


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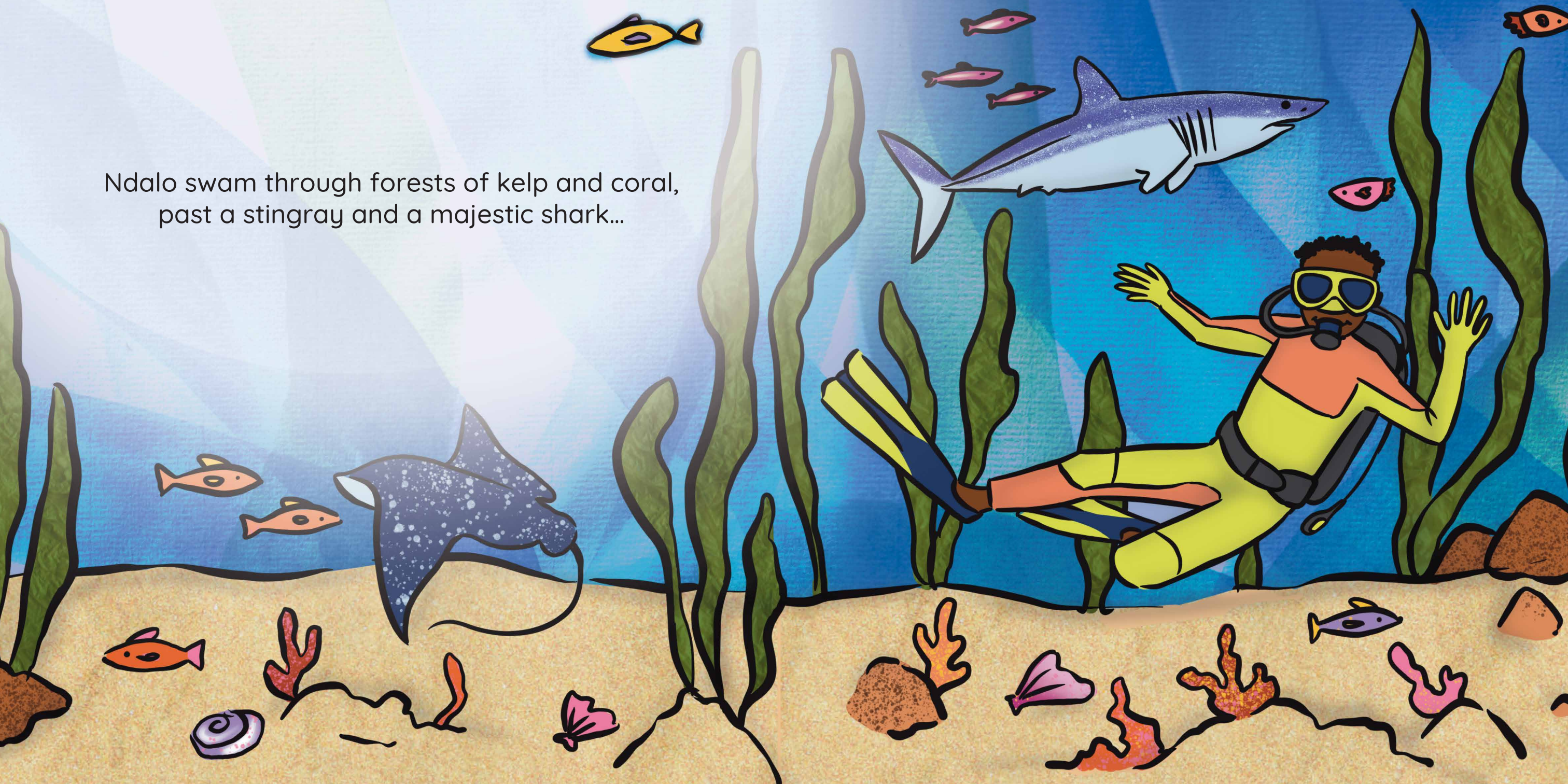
Thandi whizzed on a rollercoaster,

...all while she sat in her bedroom.

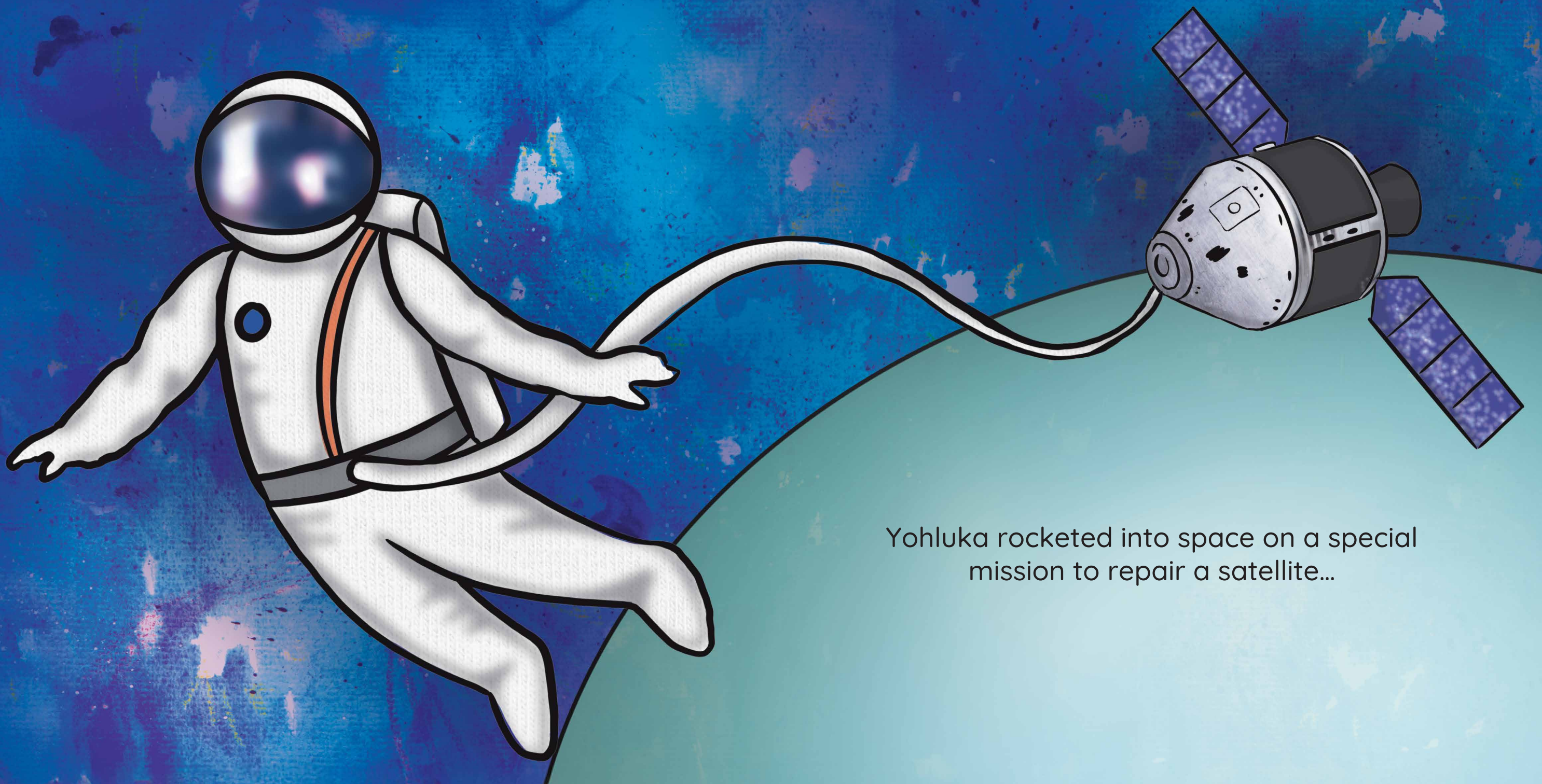


Ndalo swam through forests of kelp and coral,

...as he lay under a yellowwood tree.

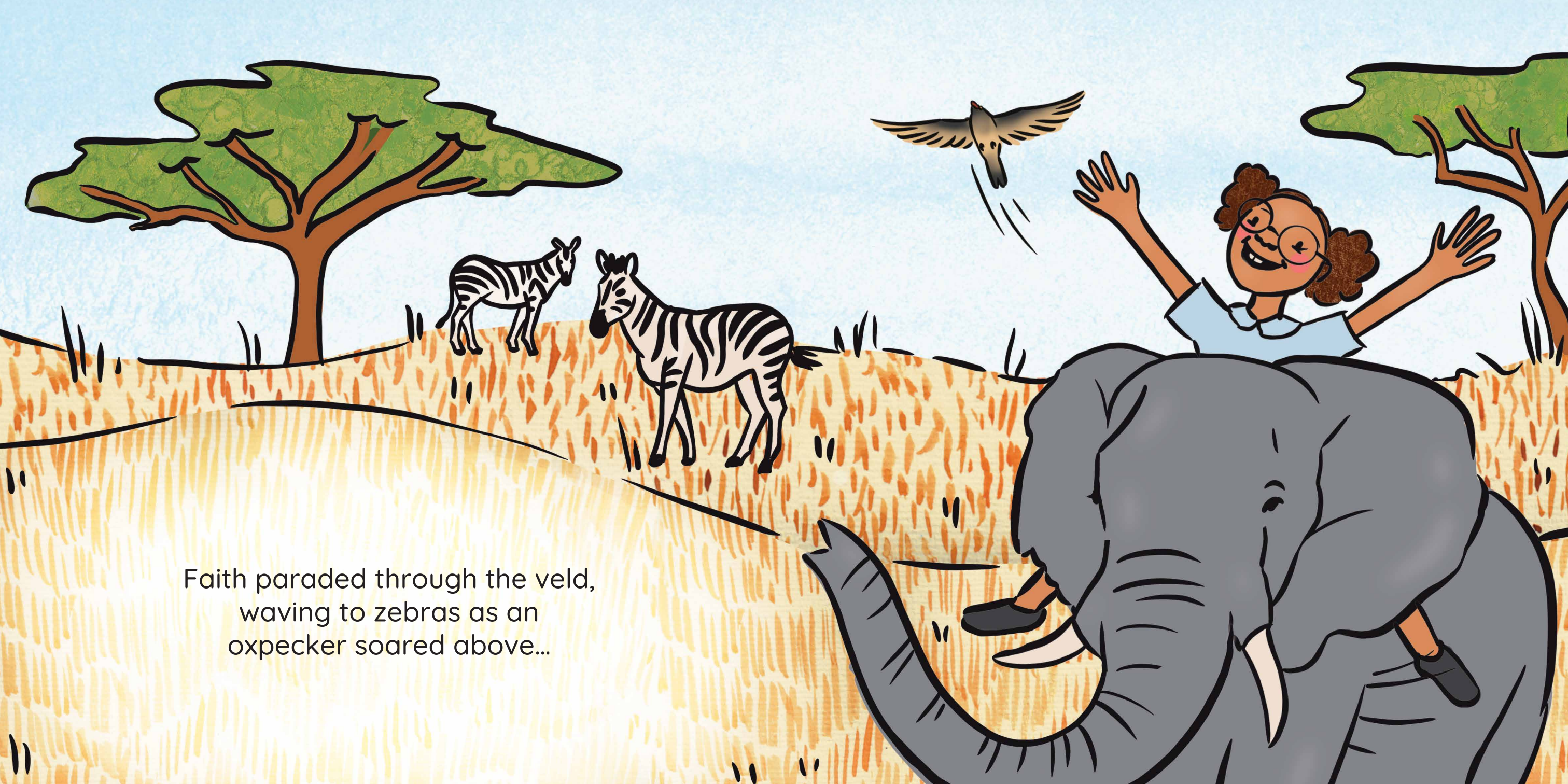




Yohluka rocketed into space on a special mission to repair a satellite...
